## LEDGE VIEW NATURE CENTER

Ledge View Nature Center may be famous for their underground caves that you can tour, but there are plenty of other activities to do with the whole family! Two miles of trails, a nature center, and a 60 ft. observation tower are a few of the attractions at Ledge View. The tower, prairie and park wildlife are photographer favorites. The park and nature center are open to the public year-round. Hours for

use of the grounds are dawn to dusk. The building is open 8-4:30 daily (closed on major holidays).

## HIGH CLIFF STATE PARK

N7630 State Park Rd, Sherwood, WI



Please check park website for attraction updates before visiting - High Cliff State Park is the only state-owned recreational area on Lake Winnebago, Wisconsin's largest inland lake. The park gets its name from the limestone cliff of the Niagara Escarpment, which parallels the eastern shore of Lake Winnebago. High Cliff State Park offers several camping opportunities for visitors, with a family campground, an

outdoor group camp and an accessible cabin for people with disabilities. The park's

marina has four boat launches and 100 slips available for rent. Rods, reels and basic tackle are available at the park office through the tackle loaner program. You can fish in the Butterfly Pond or Lake Winnebago. There is no cost to borrow the equipment. You will need to provide your own bait. Countless recreational activities for every season and extensive trail system including a trail that's adjacent to Native American Effigy Mounds. A Vehicle Admission Sticker is required to enter the park.

## **EVERGREEN VALLEY FISH FARM**

## **CALUMET COUNTY PARK**

N6150 County Rd EE, Hilbert, WI

A 230-acre park, adjacent to Lake Winnebago, features a campground, playgrounds, volleyball court, picnicking, shelter rentals, hiking/biking trails, Native American Effigy Mounds, a post-civil war brickyard, geocaching, concessions, a modern boat launch facility that provides 6 launch lanes and plenty of parking. 15 transient slips (no overnight) marina with restrooms and showers. This is a DNR approved ADA accessible launch facility. Winter activities at the park consist of sledding, snow tubing, ice fishing access to Lake Winnebago, fat tire bike trails and cross-country ski trails. Camping is available all year, but primarily from April 1 through Nov 1. We offer 71 sites, 59 of them being electric and 12 of them basic (no electricity). The electric sites have 20, 30 and some have 50 amp service. The padded sites accommodate RV's up to 40 feet in length. We have several sites for "tents only"; that are tucked into the woods. Many of our sites are along the lakeshore of Lake Winnebago.
